### YOUR GIFTS AT WORK

Thanks to your generous support in 2015, Hendricks Regional Health Foundation provided \$295,000 to enhance the mission and services of Hendricks Regional Health. Seventy-five percent was directed to enhance patient comfort, safety, and community health, with 25% reserved for medical care for patients in need.

HRH Foundation recently awarded \$22,000 to support 7 projects throughout our health system:

- Purchase 2 PlayStation systems, games, accessories and carts for Pediatric Unit
- Funds to help send local teenagers with diabetes to camp as they transition from parental care to personal care
- Purchase a blanket warmer for the Women's Center
- Help establish an assistive equipment loaner program for cancer patients
- Glucose monitors and test strips for patients in need
- Patient transportation cart
- Safe patient handling equipment

Recipients are grateful for grant funds that enable them to assist patients in ways that otherwise might not be possible. The deadline for a second round of grant awards is August 1. Fundraising efforts continue throughout 2016 to raise \$200,000 to purchase a new handicap-accessible van for patient transportation.

### PATIENT TRANSPORT VAN PLANS TAKING SHAPE

With assistance and support from Bill Estes Ford in Brownsburg, Hendricks Regional Health is one step closer to providing a new, vital service to patients who do not have transportation to help them get to vital medical appointments and treatments. Hendricks Regional Health opened a new **immediate care** facility on May 2 at 321 E. Northfield Drive in Brownsburg. Additionally, HRH hosted a long-awaited groundbreaking ceremony on April 11 to celebrate the beginning of construction for the new 100,000 square-foot **Brownsburg Medical Center** at the corner of I-74 and Ronald Reagan Parkway. That facility is expected to open in the fourth quarter of 2017 and will bring an emergency room and immediate care center, lab and radiology services, specialty clinics and other retail space together under one roof.

Our physicians, wellness and nutrition and dietetics departments work together to encourage those who are at risk of diabetes or have been diagnosed with diabetes get the ongoing care and follow up they need through an innovative and collaborative **Diabetes Prevention Program** at the HRH YMCA.
