

## SPOTLIGHT YOUR GIFTS AT WORK

Foundation board members recently approved allocation of \$13,085 for projects from four hospital departments to better serve patients. Since the internal grant program was started in 2011, \$143,509 has been awarded for 44 projects. The departments and programs receiving funds most recently included:

- Emergency Dept./EMT Training – 15-lead ECG trainer for nursing staff competency training and 800 local EMTs. An ECG shows the heart’s electrical activity and is used to diagnose heart arrhythmias, heart attacks, and heart failure.
- Pharmacy – electronic pill counter to help our pharmacists and technicians fill 1,200 prescriptions per month for patients at 6 clinics and employees.
- Long Term Care – purchase an automatic external defibrillator to treat life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias
- Childbirth Center – simulation education instruction to assist staff in neonatal simulation training

Little things really do make a big difference!

## INDISPENSABLE CARE

Our hospital received a five-star rating from Healthgrades for the quality of treatment of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD). This high rating indicates that clinical outcomes at HRH are statistically significantly better than expected when treating COPD. Because ongoing improvement of care is a primary objective at HRH, we continue to research best practices and develop new care protocols.

By demonstrating expertise in cardiac-related care, HRH once again has received full Chest Pain Center Accreditation from the Society of Cardiovascular Patient Care. The accreditation means HRH's systematic evidence-based, protocol-driven approach to cardiac patient care allows our hospital to reduced time to treatment during critical early stages of a heart attack. HRH meets or exceeds stringent criteria and has undergone a comprehensive onsite review to achieve this status.

A new short-term rehabilitation center is being established at Hendricks Regional Health Danville. This new model of care, in partnership with Golden Living Centers, is intended to serve hospital patients that need short-term rehab prior to returning home. The 26-bed short-term rehab unit is expected to be completed in December and will be operational following surveys conducted by the Indiana State Department of Health. The center will allow patients to stay within our facility until they are truly ready to go home, a blessing to many who need a bit more care following hospitalization.
