SPOTLIGHT YOUR GIFTS AT WORK

This fall, foundation board members approved allocation of \$31,590 for nine projects to better serve patients at Hendricks Regional Health. Since the internal grant program was started in 2011, \$197,600 has been awarded for 60 HRH grant projects in addition to the spotlight projects funded by donations.

Departments receiving funds most recently included:

- Preterm newborn simulation manikin for education and training
- Automatic door openers for oncology infusion center for patient assistance
- Compression wraps for physical therapy patients
- 2 AED trainers & 5 CRP manikins for wellness training and awareness
- Car transfer simulator for OT/rehab for patients following surgery
- Support & educational materials for cancer patients
- Pre-procedure patient education video for cardiac catheterization lab
- MRI-compatible bariatric wheelchair
- Digital scales for heart failure patients in cardiac rehab
